ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING

On June 14, 2016, California American Water Company and Monterey Peninsula Water Management District served an email request. The parties request a two-day extension to submit to the Commission a settlement agreement on Phase 2 issues, which they say will be a comprehensive settlement on two items. The settlement would normally be due by written motion by June 15, 2016 (i.e., 30 days after the last day of evidentiary hearing pursuant to Rule 12.1(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure). Joint parties ask for an extension until June 17, 2016.

Motions for an extension of time may be made orally, by email, or by letter. (Rule 11.6.) No other parties to the proceeding appear to be affected by the extension, and there is no known opposition. The request should be granted. The parties requesting the extension need not notify other parties of the extension (see Rule 11.6), since this Ruling is served on all parties. The opening paragraph of any motion filed by June 17, 2016 pursuant to this Ruling shall indicate that the Administrative Law Judge granted the extension by email Ruling on June 15, 2016.
