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Pursuant to Rules 8.3 and 8.4 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), EDF Renewable Energy respectfully submits this Notice of Ex Parte Communication.

On April 6, 2016, at 2:00 p.m., Cliff Graham, Vice President–Development West, and Virinder Singh, Director–Regulatory & Legislative Affairs, both of EDF Renewable Energy, and Gregory Klatt, counsel to EDF Renewable Energy, of Douglass & Liddell, met in person with Commissioner Michael Florio and Charlyn Hook, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Florio, for approximately 30 minutes. During the meeting, Messrs. Graham and Singh discussed EDF Renewable Energy’s interest in the proceeding as the new owner of the Palen Solar Power Project, provided an overview of the Palen Project in its current configuration, and explained the importance of SCE’s West of Devers Upgrade Project to EDF Renewable Energy’s ability to secure tax equity financing and a power purchase agreement to support the development of the Palen Project.
