Subject: Request for Extension of Time

Dear ALJ Mason,

Pursuant to Rule 11.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Lyft, Inc. ("Lyft") submits this motion for an extension of time for all parties to serve and file Opening and Reply Comments in response to the Assigned Commissioner's Ruling Inviting/Instructing Party Comments on Background Checks of Prospective Transportation Network Company Drivers.

Lyft requests a 60-day extension for each set of comments. Currently, Opening Comments are due on Monday, July 18, 2016, and Reply Comments on Monday,

August 1, 2016. If this motion is granted, Opening Comments would be due Friday, September 16, and Reply Comments on Friday, September 30.

The basis for Lyft's request is that the length and scope of the questions involved in the briefing will require significant resources and time to complete. There are a total of 40 questions, several of which contain numerous subparts, request citation to empirical research, and/or require in-depth analysis and comparison of multiple background check methods. Lyft fully intends to provide a robust response to each question, but requires more time to do so. This is especially true given that Lyft is simultaneously preparing responses to other CPUC briefing on personal vehicles, the deadlines for which are July 11 (Opening Comments) and July 25 (Reply Comments). The same Lyft team members are working on both sets of comments.

On June 29, pursuant to Rule 11.6, Lyft contacted all parties to these proceedings by email, informing them of our intention to make this motion and requesting that they respond by June 30 stating whether they will support or oppose the 60-day extension. (Lyft sent this email after receiving an email from the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) and the San Francisco International Airport (SFO) stating that they would be requesting a shorter extension.)

The following parties responded that they support or do not oppose Lyft's 60-day extension request: GM and Maven Drive (support); Rasier-CA, LLC (support); San Francisco Taxi Workers Alliance (no objection). No parties have objected.

We appreciate your consideration of this motion.
