Subject: A.13-06-018 EMAIL RULING: Requesting Motions to Move Exhibits Into the Record and for Confidential Treatment

Dear Golden State Water/ Bear Valley Electric,

In anticipation of a proposed decision in Phase II of A.13-06-018, Golden State Water, on behalf of its Bear Valley Electric division (BVES), should tender a motion to move Phase II testimony/exhibits into the record. Please follow these instructions:

- 1) BVES must submit to me 1 copy of the public version of Volume 3 testimony and a 1 copy of the confidential testimony that clearly denotes the confidential information. (I only have in my possession a copy of the confidential testimony and it does not show which information contained therein is confidential.)
- 2) The public version of Volume 3 testimony shall be numbered BVES 22
- 3) The confidential version of Volume 3 testimony shall be numbered BVES 23 (to keep with the sequence adopted in Phase 1).

BVES must also submit a motion seeking confidential treatment of Exhibit BVES 23. The motion must site to the specific governing principles under which confidentiality is sought.

Please submit these motions (which may be combined in one single motion if desired) by end of day Friday, September 23, 2016.

On a going forward basis, please note that the Commission recently issued Decision 16-08-024 updating our confidentiality practices. Although not applicable to this testimony, on a going forward basis, BVES is advised that testimony submitted absent a complete declaration or motion for confidential treatment will be considered public information. Future served testimony can include either a signed declaration citing the nature of the confidential information (and governing authority if applicable) OR BVES can file a motion seeking confidential treatment (even though the testimony is not yet part of the formal record). In the past it has been customary to wait until such time as the evidence is moved into the record; however, under this new decision, that will create a gap of coverage during which the material could be made public.

THE DOCKET OFFICE SHALL FORMALLY FILE THIS RULING.
