Pursuant to Rules 11.1 and 13.8 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the California Farm Bureau Federation ("Farm Bureau") moves for admission of written testimony it served on August 29, 2016 on the parties to this proceeding.

On August 29, 2016, in accordance with the schedule established in this proceeding pursuant to the Scoping Memo and Ruling of Assigned Commissioner dated August 19, 2016, Farm Bureau served its Direct Testimony of the California Farm Bureau Federation Concerning Pacific Gas & Electric's 2017 Energy Resource Recovery Account and Generation Non-Bypassable Charges Forecast and Greenhouse Gas Forecast Revenue Return Application ("Testimony") prepared by witness Brandon Charles, a copy of which is being served currently with this Motion. Through this Motion, Farm Bureau is offering the Testimony into evidence in lieu of submission of the Testimony at an evidentiary hearing.

For the reasons stated above, California Farm Bureau Federation requests the identified Testimony be admitted into the record in this proceeding.


