MOTION OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO, CITY OF PISMO BEACH, CITY OF PASO ROBLES, CITY OF ARROYO GRANDE, CITY OF MORRO BAY, AND CITY OF ATASCADERO FOR PARTY STATUS

Pursuant to Rules 1.4 and 11.1 of the California Public Utilities Commission’s (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure, the City of San Luis Obispo, City of Pismo Beach, City of Paso Robles, City of Arroyo Grande, City of Morro Bay, and City of Atascadero (collectively, the “Nearby Cities”) each respectfully file this motion for party status in the above-entitled proceeding.

The Nearby Cities desire party status for the following reasons. The Nearby Cities are all located in the vicinity of the Diablo Canyon Power Plant (“Diablo Canyon”) and each of the Nearby Cities will be significantly affected in both the short- and long-term by Diablo Canyon’s closure. Diablo Canyon is a significant generator of economic benefits and public tax revenue for the Nearby Cities. Many residents of the Nearby Cities are employed directly and indirectly by PG&E and its contractors. Diablo Canyon provides financial support and services to social organizations and charities that operate in the Nearby Cities. Reliable and predictable electrical

power produced by Diablo Canyon or its replacement is essential for the continued social well-being and economic growth to the Nearby Cities. The future of the Nearby Cities and its residents is directly impacted by the outcome of these proceedings. Recent developments and announcements regarding the future of Diablo Canyon are of significant concern to these communities, and participation by the Nearby Cities in these proceedings is warranted. For these reasons, the Nearby Cities request party status in order to allow full participation by the Nearby Cities in the Commission's process for review and consideration of PG&E's Application regarding the closure Diablo Canyon.
