ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING REQUIRING APPLICANT TO FILE A RESPONSE TO INFORMATION REQUEST WITHIN 15 DAYS

Upon review of Tech Verb's application, the Commission requires the following additional information regarding this application:

- 1) Will Tech Verb provide local exchange service in addition to interexchange service?
- 2) Will Tech Verb operate in the service territories of AT&T, Frontier California, Frontier Communications, or Consolidated?
- 3) Will Tech Verb provide services to business or residential customers or both?
- 4) Please provide the estimated customer base for the first and fifth years of operation?
- 5) Will the initial services offered by Tech Verb constitute broadband data services only? if yes, do you seek an exemption from an initial tariff filing prior to offering local exchange services?
- 6) Do you seek treatment as a non-dominant interexchange carrier? and
- 7) Does Tech Verb plan on selling voice services in the future?
