**REPLY COMMENTS FROM EVERCAR RE: ASSIGNED COMMISSIONER’S RULING
INVITING PARTY COMMENTS ON THE CONCEPT OF PERSONAL VEHICLES**

1. Definition of Personal Vehicle

Evercar would like to support and adopt the following definition.

“Personal Vehicle” means a vehicle that is used by a Transportation Network Company Driver in connection with providing a Prearranged Ride and is owned or leased by the Transportation Network Company Driver or is otherwise authorized for use by the Transportation Network Company Driver by the vehicle’s legal owner.

2. Insurance Products exist that Cover Multiple Drivers Using a Single Vehicle for Commercial Purposes within a 24-hour Timeframe

San Francisco Airport and San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency mentions in its response to Question 7 that it has not found any insurance product “that would cover multiple drivers using a single vehicle for commercial purposes within a 24-hour time frame.”

Evercar recently solicited and received quotes from commercial insurers, where coverage would be extended to multiple drivers using a single vehicle for commercial within a 24-hour time frame.
