**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES' RULING  
SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

Notice is hereby given, a prehearing conference (PHC) will be held on Tuesday, October 25, 2016, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's Courtroom, State Office Building, 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94102, regarding the General Rate Case Application of Southern California Edison Company (SCE) for authority to increase electric rates and charges effective January 1, 2018.

The PHC will address the scope and schedule for the proceeding, establish the service list, and address other procedural issues that may arise. PHC statements may be submitted and should be filed and served no later than October 18, 2016. PHC statements should address the following:

- Procedural schedule;
- Scope of issues to be included in (or excluded from) the proceeding;
- Need for evidentiary hearings;
- Appropriate category for this proceeding;
- Discovery issues; and
- List and description of other matters the parties wish to address at the PHC.

SCE should meet and confer with those parties that file either a protest to the application or a PHC statement and, to the extent possible, resolve conflicts in proposed schedules, scope of issues, and/or other matters listed above prior to the PHC.

**IT IS RULED** that:

1. A prehearing conference is set for 10:00 a.m., on Tuesday, October 25, 2016, at the Commission's Courtroom, State Office Building, 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94102.

2. Prehearing conference statements addressing the items listed above shall be filed no later than October 18, 2016, and served on the service list for this proceeding, as well as on the assigned Commissioner and Administrative Law Judges.

3. Southern California Edison Company shall meet and confer with those parties that file either a protest to the application or a prehearing conference (PHC) statement, and to the extent possible, resolve conflicts in proposed schedules and/or the other procedural matters listed above prior to the PHC.
