Pursuant to Rule 8.3 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Entravision Communications Corporation ("Entravision") hereby submits this Notice of Oral Ex Parte Communication.

On Wednesday, May 4, 2016, Entravision representatives Marcelo Gaete, Vice President of Public and Governmental Affairs; Mark Boelke, General Counsel and Vice President of Legal Affairs; Jeff Liberman, Chief Operating Officer, and Anita Taff-Rice, outside counsel, had a telephone conversation with Commissioner Catherine Sandoval and William Johnston, her telecommunications advisor. The call began at approximately 2:15 p.m. and lasted for approximately 30 minutes. The call was initiated by Entravision.

During the call the Entravision representatives expressed support for the proposed merger between Charter and Time Warner Cable based on Charter's willingness to engage with national and local communities regarding access to the merged entity's broadband network for provision of independent, diverse programming and improving broadband availability for low income customers and other California consumers, and also based on the proposed conditions in the Commission's proposed decision. In particular, Entravision expressed support for the proposed condition under which Charter will assume Lifeline services currently provided by TWC and to do so with no disruption of service to low-income consumers.
