Subject: A.16-06-002: EMAIL RULING REQUIRING A JOINT STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND WITNESSES FOR EVIDENTIARY HEARING

The August 16, 2016 Scoping Memo and Ruling scheduled an evidentiary hearing on November 8, 9, and 10, 2016 commencing at 9:30 a.m. each day. The parties should anticipate approximately 4½ hours of hearing each day with sessions from 9:30 a.m. to 12 noon and 1:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. with a 15 minute break during each session. In the interest of judicial economy and to limit hearing time, and where feasible, parties should seek to enter into stipulations of facts or other dispute resolution. To the extent issues are not resolved prior to the hearing, in order to facilitate the orderly scheduling of witnesses and minimize cross-examination,

IT IS RULED:

1. The parties shall jointly prepare a list of contested issues of fact in this proceeding. The contested issues of fact should include a brief summary of each party's position concerning each contested fact and identify the witness thereto who will be the subject of cross-examination.
2. The parties shall jointly prepare a list of witnesses for cross-examination and a schedule reflecting the order of witnesses and time estimates for examination of each witness.
3. On behalf of the parties, the applicant, San Diego Gas and Electric, shall send via electronic mail a statement consisting of: the joint list of contested issues of fact and joint list of witnesses and cross examination schedule and addressing

any other matters the parties deem relevant, to the assigned Administrative Law Judge and the service list for A.16-06-002, no later than November 1, 2016.
