AN AMENDED APPLICATION WITH THE COMMISSION ON OR BEFORE
NOVEMBER 10, 2016

On September 1, 2016, CuraTel, LLC d/b/a La Curacao (U6610C) (CuraTel) filed an application to Withdraw from providing local exchange and Interexchange telecommunication services including basic service, and to relinquish its eligible telecommunications carrier designation.

A review of the application shows that CuraTel's application is incomplete as: (1) information needed to substantively evaluate the application are missing from the application; and (2) the application fails to demonstrate that CuraTel has complied with the Mass Migration Guidelines set forth in Rulemaking 03-06-020 (Decision 06-10-021 (Voluntary Exits); or Decision 10-07-024 (Involuntary Exits)). Accordingly, **in order to continue the evaluation of the application, CuraTel must file an Amended Application on or before November 10, 2016.**

The Amended Application shall demonstrate the extent to which CuraTel has complied with the Mass Migration Guidelines set forth in Decision 06-10-021 or Decision 10-07-024. Specifically, CuraTel's Amended Application shall include the following information and/or supporting details, among other requirements for exiting (established in Decision 06-10-021 and/or Decision 10-07-024):

- 1) The dates and details of notice(s) CuraTel provided to its customers;

- 2) The date when CuraTel provided its customers' list to the Commission as required by Decision 06-10-021 and/or Decision 10-07-024, and relevant details regarding the information provided;
- 3) The kind of service CuraTel's customers would receive from TimeWarner/Charter (Spectrum) after the mass migration process has been completed;
- 4) Information regarding whether CuraTel has discussed its exit plan with its "arranged carrier" and/or "default carrier";
- 5) Information regarding whether CuraTel's customers who failed to make an election would be migrated to the "arranged carrier" all at once;
- 6) Information regarding whether the mass migration process will require customers' premises visits;
- 7) Information regarding whether CuraTel has discussed its exit plan with AT&T and Frontier so both are aware that CuraTel customers may be coming to them; and
- 8) List of actions already taken by Curatel in the implementation of its exit plan (rather than what CuraTel intends to do in the future).

Therefore, IT IS RULED that:

1. CuraTel, LLC, shall file an Amended Application, as directed herein above, on or before **5:00 p.m., on November 10, 2016**. The filing of the Amended Application shall be made in accordance with Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.
2. Failure to file the Amended Application, as directed herein, may result in the dismissal of this application without prejudice.

IT IS SO RULED.
