ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
SAN LUIS OBISPO MOTHERS FOR PEACE, INC.

I

The name of the corporation is San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace, Inc.

II

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

(a) San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace is a non-partisan organization whose primary and specific purpose is to further the educational, scientific and charitable interests of the community by making the world a safer and more humane place to live for the present and in the future.

The organization is dedicated to the principal that war is obsolete - that non-violent methods must be creatively sought and implemented to resolve differences.

The organization is further dedicated to the principal of educating people to an awareness of the critical need for maintaining a balance between people and their natural environment.

The organization seeks to achieve its purpose by means of concerted efforts to increase mailings to public officials, by educational distributions and rallies, writing letters to the editors of newspapers, the holding of vigils, providing speakers to comment on topics of community concern,

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sponsoring films and workshops for the public, and contributing money to appropriate groups and individuals as defined in these Articles.

(b) The general purposes and powers are to have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on non-profit corporations under the laws of California, including the power to contract, rent, buy or sell personal or real property, the power to borrow money and issue bonds and notes; provided, however, that this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of this corporation.

### III

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of California and does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and it is organized for non-profit purposes.

### IV

The county in this State where the principal office for the transaction of the business of the corporation is located in San Luis Obispo County.

### V

VI

Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board of Directors under any provision of law may be taken without a meeting, if all members of the Board shall individually or collectively consent in writing to such action. Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the Board. Such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as the unanimous vote of such Directors.

Any certificate or other document filed under any provision of law which relates to action so taken shall state that the action was taken by the unanimous written consent of the Board of Directors without a meeting and that the Articles of Incorporation authorize the Directors to so act, and such statement shall be prima facie evidence of such authority.

VII

(a) Directors. The manner in which Directors

shall be chosen and removed from office, their qualifications, powers, duties, compensation, and tenure of office, the manner of calling and holding meetings of Directors, shall be as stated in the By-Laws.

(b) Members. The authorized number, if any, and qualifications of members of the corporation, the filling of vacancies, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability to dues and assessments and the method of collection, and the termination and transfer of membership shall be as stated in the By-Laws.

#### VIII

(a) The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to scientific, educational and charitable purposes meeting the requirements of Sec. 23701d of the Revenue and Taxation Code, and no part of the net income or assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private persons.

(b) On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of the corporation shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for scientific, educational and charitable purposes, meeting the requirements for exemption provided by Section 23701d of the Revenue and Taxation Code, and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(c) If this corporation holds any assets on Trust, or the corporation is formed for charitable purposes, such assets shall be disposed of in such manner as may be directed by decree of the Superior Court of the county in which the corporation has its principal office, on petition therefor by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation, in a proceeding to which the Attorney General is a party.

(d) All funds collected by this corporation from the public are expressly dedicated to the primary purpose of this corporation as stated in the Articles and no such funds will be paid out to groups or individuals unless such funds are to be used exclusively to further the primary purpose of this corporation.


