ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING NOTICING WORKSHOP

Decision 14-12-024 authorized a study on the potential of demand response in California. The purpose of the 2015 Demand Response Potential Study (Study) is to determine the potential of demand response in California based on value and on need. A March 4, 2016 Ruling announced that the results from the Study would be delivered to the Commission in two phases with the interim phase one results delivered on April 1, 2016 and the phase two results originally expected to be delivered by September 1, 2016. The draft phase two results were delivered to parties on November 14, 2016.

This Ruling notices a workshop in Rulemaking 13-09-011 to present and discuss the draft results of phase two of the Study. The workshop will take place on Wednesday, November 30, 2016 at 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. in the Commission's Auditorium at 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94102. The purpose of the workshop is to provide the consulting team, the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, an opportunity to present its phase two findings of the Study. Parties will be given the opportunity to ask the consulting team questions about the Study. Following the workshop, the Administrative Law Judge will issue a

ruling taking comment on the Study and asking parties to respond to specific questions.
