**Subject:** A.12-04-019 Email Ruling Granting Motion of City of Marina for Party Status

**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING**

On March 23, 2017, the City of Marina (Marina) moved for party status. Marina states it has a direct and substantial interest in the remaining issues within Application 12-04-019. Marina moves for party status to actively participate, such as in the filing of briefs, the filing of comments on the Proposed Decision, the filing of other authorized formal pleadings, and the participation in any hearings, workshops or other matters scheduled or required in this proceeding. The motion reasonably discloses the entity in whose behalf the motion is made, states the interest of such entity, identifies the factual and legal contentions that the entity intends to make, and shows the contentions are pertinent to the issues already presented. (Rule 1.4 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.) Marina does not seek to broaden the issues or delay the schedule. The motion should be granted.

Marina, and all parties, are reminded that the appropriate place to critique and comment on the draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) is in comments on the draft EIR. While parties may use information in the draft EIR to support their briefs, the briefs are not to be used for critiquing the draft EIR. (See Rulings dated May 30, 2013; June 29, 2015; and January 13, 2017.)

**IT IS RULED** that the March 23, 2017 motion of the City of Marina for party status is granted. The Docket Office shall formally file this Ruling.
