JOINT STATUS UPDATE

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May 10, 2017

The Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) and Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby provide the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) in this proceeding with a monthly status update, as required by the ALJ in the ALJ's January 10, 2017 ruling suspending the procedural schedule in this matter.

Since the last update on April 10, 2017, SCE and SED participated in two conference calls to further discuss the terms of a settlement agreement as well as the joint motion for approval of the agreement. The parties anticipate filing the joint motion and agreement before the next scheduled update on June 10, 2017, and possibly sooner.

SED and SCE both believe that progress continues to be made toward a complete and comprehensive settlement of this matter. Therefore, they request that the ALJ maintain the schedule suspension.
