To Parties and Others on the Official Address List:

The ALJ received and reviewed the attached August 8, 2017 SCE/ORa Joint Procedural Email regarding hearings scheduled August 22 - 25, 2017. The parties note that SCE's responses to the data requests are not due until August 11. The ALJ's determinations on questions posed the August 8 email, including whether ALJ agrees that scheduled evidentiary hearing (EH) should be taken off calendar, depends upon the particulars of the responses to ORa's data requests.

SCE is ordered to file (through the Docket Office) a copy of its responses to the data requests in the August 8, 2017 email to the assigned ALJ and to the Commission's Energy Division concurrent with response to ORa.

Upon receipt and review of the responses, the ALJ will issue further ruling concerning the scheduled EH.

To ALJ Patricia Miles

Dear Judge Miles:

I am writing to inform you that the Office of Ratepayer Advocates (ORA) and Southern California Edison Company (SCE) met and conferred on the need for hearings. ORA agreed to waive the hearings the Commission scheduled to commence on August 22, but its waiver is contingent upon it being able to move SCE's response to outstanding data requests into the record of this proceeding. SCE's responses to the data requests are due on Friday, August 11. SCE does not and will not oppose ORA's motion to incorporate SCE's data request responses into the record.

ORA and SCE therefore respectfully request procedural guidance on how to obtain a determination on the issue of moving the DR responses into the record. Typically, evidence is moved into the record (under Rules 13.8 and 11.1), the matter is submitted, and the record is closed (see Rule 13.14

(a)) after the conclusion of hearings and closing briefing. Here, to obviate the need for hearings, ORA likely requires a determination on whether SCE's responses can be incorporated into the record in advance of the August 22 hearing. If no hearings occur, the parties propose to file their respective written motions to offer evidence into the record on August 18.

If, upon receipt of SCE's response to the data requests, ORA determines that the responses need not be part of the evidentiary record, ORA will promptly notify the ALJ and service list.

If your honor finds no determination can be made on the issue in advance of hearings, ORA requests the Commission afford it a one day hearing on matters pertinent to the issues raised in its current set of outstanding data requests.

The data requests at issue are attached to this correspondence.
