## ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING NOTICING COMMUNITY MEETINGS AND ATTENDANCE BY ONE OR MORE COMMISSIONERS AND ADVISORS AT THE MEETINGS

Commissioner Carla J. Peterman of the California Public Utilities

Commission (CPUC) will preside over a community meeting in December 2017

regarding the vehicle transportation electrification proposals that were filed in

response to Senate Bill 350 (Stats. 2015, Ch. 547). The community meeting will

allow the Commissioner, CPUC staff, and members of the public to discuss the

impact of the transportation electrification applications and proposals of Pacific

Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, and San Diego

Gas & Electric Company on local communities, and to gather feedback on

It is expected that one or more Commissioners will attend and participate at the community meeting. However, no vote or action of the CPUC will take place at these community meetings. The Commissioners' advisors and the assigned Administrative Law Judges may also be in attendance at the community meetings.

Rule 8.1(c) of the CPUC's Rules of Practice and Procedure states in part that an *ex parte* communication means a written or oral communication that "does not occur in a public hearing, workshop, or other public forum noticed by ruling or order in the proceeding, or in the record of the proceeding." The community meeting is being noticed through this ruling, and will appear in the CPUC's Daily Calendar. As a result, any discussion regarding the issues in these proceedings at the community meeting is not subject to the *ex parte* reporting requirement for the aforementioned consolidated proceedings.
