**Subject:** Email Ruling in A.17-12-016 Requesting Additional Information from Applicants

Applicants magicJack VocalTec Ltd. (Transferor) and B. Riley Financial, Inc. (Transferee) request authorization of the transfer of control of YMAX Communications Corp. (U-6989-C) (YMAX). I have determined that the Commission needs additional information to consider the application. Please provide:

- 1) An update of the status of the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC) Enforcement Bureau's current letter of inquiry investigation concerning YMAX.
- 2) Please also provide copies of all three letters of inquiry from the FCC Enforcement Bureau, including those from 2010 and 2013, any written responses of YMAX to the FCC Enforcement Bureau, and any other written correspondence including emails between the FCC Enforcement Bureau and YMAX relating to the three investigations.

Within seven days of the date of this ruling, the Applicants must serve and file the additional information requested above. Applicant's filing must be titled "Response to Administrative Law Judge Inquiry"; otherwise a new protest period will be triggered.
