**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING  
REQUESTING ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

On October 6, 2017, San Diego Gas and Electric Company (SDG&E) and Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) filed their respective General Rate Case (GRC) applications for the Test Year 2019 GRC period. The GRC applications were to incorporate and use as a basis SDG&E's and SoCalGas' assessment of their safety risks conducted in these Risk Assessment and Mitigation Phase (RAMP) proceedings.

In order to properly assess whether key risks and proposed programs for mitigating these risks were incorporated into their GRC applications, SDG&E and SoCalGas are required to submit additional information identifying the testimonies in their respective GRC applications where the RAMP risks were incorporated. The information shall be presented in tabular form and shall be due within 20 days from the date of this ruling.

**IT IS RULED** that:

1. San Diego Gas and Electric Company and Southern California Gas Company shall file additional information identifying the testimonies in their respective General Rate Case applications where RAMP risks were incorporated.
2. The information described above shall be presented in tabular form and shall be due within 20 days from the date of this ruling.
