Subject: A1706030 Email Ruling Modifying Date for Testimony and Declining to Specify a Discovery Deadline

Parties- On March 6, 2019 a number of parties made a joint filing seeking a delay in serving testimony because of service issues with ORA's opening testimony that delayed delivery of the testimony to other parties. SCE and ORA responded to the motion on March 9, 2018.

Good cause being shown, I approve a delay in service of testimony by one week to March 23, 2018. The remainder of the schedule remains the same.

The motion also requested that I direct ORA to respond to discovery requests within 10 days. I decline to specify a shorter discovery period but urge ORA (and all parties responding to data responses) to do so as quickly as possible rather than waiting for the full 10 days allowed.
