Decision PROPOSED DECISION OF ALJ YACKNIN (Mailed 6/6/2018)**BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

Application of TELECOM NORTH AMERICA INC., dba TELNA INC. for Registration as an Interexchange Carrier Telephone Corporation Pursuant to the Provisions of Public Utilities Code Section 1013.

DECISION DISMISSING APPLICATION FOR LACK OF PROSECUTION**Summary**

Telecom North America Inc., dba Telna Inc., filed this application for a registration license as an interexchange telephone carrier on December 26, 2013. A few months later, Telna filed a separate Application (A.) 14-03-014 for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide resold long distance telecommunications services, which was granted by Decision 14-10-008.

In April 2017, Telna tendered a motion to withdraw the instant application. The Docket Office rejected the motion for technical deficiencies, which Telna has not sought to cure. Telna has not taken any action in this matter since.

Accordingly, we dismiss A.13-12-017 for lack of prosecution.

1. Categorization and Need for Hearing

We affirm the Commission's preliminary categorization of this proceeding as ratesetting and preliminary determination that hearing is not needed.
