Parties to A.15-05-002 et al,

A "Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement Plus Request for Receipt into the Record of Previously Served Documents and for Expedited Comment Period of Pacific Gas and Electric Company (U-39 E), Southern California Edison Company (U-338 E), Southern California Gas Company (U-904 G), San Diego Gas & Electric Company (U-902 M), the Office of Ratepayer Advocates, The Utility Reform Network, and Energy Producers and Users Coalition and Indicated Shippers" (Joint Motion of Settling Parties) was filed in this proceeding on May 3, 2018. The Joint Motion moved that the Commission find the Settlement Agreement to be in the public interest, reasonable in light of the entire record and consistent with the law and requested that the Commission promptly adopt a standalone decision approving the Settlement Agreement without modification.

The Settling Parties also requested that the comment period for parties to file comments contesting all or part of the settlement agreement be shortened to 15 days rather than the 30 days allowed by Rule 12.2. The Settling Parties indicate that they sent an email to the service list on April 23, 2018 expressing their intent to request a 15 day comment period and received no objections. The Settling Parties further indicated willingness to participate in a Commission-sponsored workshop to present the proposed agreement and answer questions.

We hereby shorten the comment period on the Joint Motion to three weeks. Parties shall provide Opening Comments on the proposed Agreement no later than May 24, 2018. Reply comments shall be filed within two weeks of this date, no later than June 7, 2018. We request that parties respond in their comments to the Settling Parties' proposal to adopt a standalone decision on the Agreement.

With notice to the service list, we also direct the Settling Parties to convene a webinar during the period of May 14 – 22, the purpose of which will be to introduce the Settlement Agreement to interested parties and answer questions.

Finally, Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) staff will notice and convene a workshop exploring the Settlement Agreement in greater depth in the latter half of June, 2018. Parties are requested in their comments to provide suggestions for agenda items for this workshop. If parties have any scheduling issues they should directly contact SED staff.
