**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING PREHEARING  
CONFERENCE AND NOTICING STAFF WORKSHOPS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a prehearing conference (PHC) is set on August 6, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. in the Commission's San Francisco Auditorium located at the State Office Building, 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94102.

The PHC will address the categorization, scope and schedule for this proceeding, confirm the service list, and other issues as they arise.

In addition, the Commission is considering establishing several working groups with specific tasks to address the questions raised in the Order Instituting Rulemaking. A ruling will issue prior to the PHC providing more detail about the working groups.

Preceding the PHC at 10:30 a.m., staff will host a workshop with a live demonstration of the Cal-Adapt tool for interested parties. Immediately following the PHC, the staff workshop will continue as several experts discuss both Cal-Adapt and other existing climate adaptation data, studies and tools. These workshops will not be reported or part of the record. Further detail about the staff workshops including an agenda and speakers will be forthcoming.

**IT IS RULED** that:

1. A Prehearing Conference is set for 1:00 p.m. on August 6, 2018 in the Commission's San Francisco Auditorium located at the State Office Building, 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94102.
2. Staff workshops as detailed herein will precede and follow the PHC.
3. Following the Prehearing Conference, Commissioner Randolph will issue a scoping memo which will set forth the issues and schedule for this proceeding pursuant to Rule 7.3.
