A.17-05-004 – ALJ’S EMAIL RULING REQUESTING ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF THE JUNE 22, 2018 JOINT STIPULATION

TO ALL PARTIES

On June 22, 2018, the Public Advocates Office of the California Public Utilities Commission and Bear Valley Electric Service (together herein, “the Settling Parties”) filed with the Commission a joint “Stipulation on Depreciation, Cost of Capital and Certain Non-Revenue Issues” (Stipulation). The Settling Parties requested to enter the Stipulation into the record of this proceeding.

A review of the submitted Stipulation reveals that additional information is required in order to fully evaluate the Stipulation/Settlement, and determine if it should be approved by the Commission pursuant to Article 12.1 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure. Accordingly, the Settling Parties are directed to submit (**file and serve**), in the docket of this proceeding, the following additional information:

1. An exhibit reflecting the stipulated positions and Settlement, in comparison to the parties’ contested/original positions.
2. For each of the Settling Parties, the final/adjusted Results of Operations (RO) models (reflecting all adjustments to their overall proposed revenue requirements) as a result of the Joint Stipulation/Settlement.

ORDER

1. The Settling Parties are directed to provide the information requested above on or before 5:00 PM, October 24, 2018.
2. The record in the proceeding shall remain open until further ruling in this proceeding.
