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**I. INTRODUCTION**

Pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge's September 19, 2018 *E-Mail Ruling Ordering All Investor-Owned Utilities, Community Choice Aggregators, and Electric Service Providers to File and Serve Updates to Their Draft 2018 Renewable Portfolio Standard Procurement Plans to Address Senate Bill 100*, and the Administrative Law Judge's September 24, 2018 *E-Mail Ruling Granting, in part, Request of Investor-Owned Utilities, Community Choice Aggregators, and Electric Service Providers for an Extension of Time to File and Serve Updates to 2018 RPS Plans*,<sup>1</sup> Calpine PowerAmerica-CA, LLC ("CPA") submits the below update.

As noted in CPA's 2018 Renewables Portfolio Standard ("RPS") Procurement Plan filed August 20, 2018, CPA only serves two main customers and its forward demand forecast is based on its customers' historical load growth. CPA uses its 20-year forward supply/demand forecast to identify its expected RPS compliance obligations and net RPS procurement requirements going forward. However, CPA's existing customer contracts do not extend through the entire 20-year forecast period.

Unless the customer contracts are renewed/extended, or CPA obtains a new retail customer(s), CPA may not provide retail service throughout the entire forecast period. Accordingly, while CPA intends to comply with Senate Bill (“SB”) 100’s requirements if it is providing retail service during the relevant time periods, CPA does not have any updates to its current 2018 RPS Procurement Plan. As there are no changes to its plan, CPA is not submitting a revised 2018 RPS Procurement Plan.
