To the service list for A.18-06-001:

On October 23, 2018, the California Large Energy Consumers Association (CLECA) filed a Motion for Party Status in this proceeding.

Rule 1.4 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure addresses participation in Commission proceedings. Pursuant to Rule 1.4 (b), a person seeking party status by motion shall:

(1) fully disclose the persons or entities in whose behalf the filing, appearance or motion is made, and the interest of such persons or entities in the proceeding; and

(2) state the factual and legal contentions that the person intends to make and show that the contentions will be reasonably pertinent to the issues already presented.

Rule 1.4 (c) states that the assigned Administrative Law Judge may, where circumstances warrant, deny party status or limit the degree to which a party may participate in the proceeding.

With respect to Rule 1.4(b)(1), CLECA states its members are large, high load factor and high voltage industrial customers of PG&E and SCE and its members rates will be impacted by the outcome of this proceeding.

With respect to Rule 1.4(b)(2), CLECA states it intends to support rational forecasting of fuel and purchased power expenses, sales and load, pragmatic integration of the recent PCIA decision and compliance with prior decisions on the PCIA and CAM.

Therefore, **IT IS RULED**, the motion is granted; the California Large Energy Consumers Association meets the requirements of Rule 1.4 (b) and is granted party status.
