This email ruling grants Miron Enterprises, Limited Liability Company's (Miron or Applicant) request to appear telephonically at the prehearing conference set for January 25, 2019 at 1:30 pm in San Francisco.

The grant to appear telephonically is limited to the prehearing conference and does not extend to other parties in this proceeding. Miron filed an application in the State of California and, therefore, it may be required to appear in person before the Commission, in its hearing rooms located in San Francisco and Los Angeles, in the future.

Going forward, only requests from the person listed as the Applicant's representative on the service list will be considered. Florin Miron is currently listed as the party representative. If another individual is authorized to act on behalf of Miron as the active attorney, the person must request to be listed as Miron's representative on the service list in the "Party" category.

The Commission's practice is to list only one representative per party in the "Party" category of the official service list. Other representatives of the same party wishing to receive communications in the proceeding may be placed on the service list in the "Information Only" category by sending an email request to the Commission's Process Office (process_office@cpuc.ca.gov).
