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**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF COMMUNICATIONS:** SCE expressed its support for the Proposed Decision (PD) issued in A.14-06-021 and A.14-12-07, which are consolidated, particularly with regard to the (1) proposed OFO noncompliance charge structure for the summer months; (2) proposal to review the OFO noncompliance charge structure in the Triennial Cost Allocation Proceeding; and (3) proposed implementation timing. SCE explained why the proposed settlement is insufficient to protect its customers and that the treatment proposed in the PD for the summer is particularly important for SCE and its customers, which are not similarly situated to the other parties to the consolidated proceeding because of its inability to hedge and because of the requirements for CAISO-interconnected electric generators. SCE also discussed how both the current and the proposed OFO noncompliance charge structure for the winter impact gas prices when the gas system is experiencing restrictions on gas storage and transmission. SCE also indicated that it might raise this issue in appropriate proceedings in the future to protect its customers. Finally, SCE encouraged the Commission to approve the proposed decision expeditiously and to issue a final decision in time for implementation for this summer.

**WHO INITIATED COMMUNICATION:** SCE initiated the communication, and on May 2, 2019, timely provided advance notice that the offices above granted SCE’s requests for meetings.
