**ORDER EXTENDING STATUTORY DEADLINE**

**Summary**

This decision extends the statutory deadline in this proceeding to February 11, 2013.

**Background**

Public Utilities Code Section 1701.5(a) provides that ratesetting cases, such as this proceeding, shall be resolved within 18 months of the date on which the scoping memo is issued, unless the Commission makes findings regarding why that deadline cannot be met and issues an order extending the 18-month deadline for a period not exceeding 60 days.

The amended scoping memo for this proceeding was issued on June 14, 2012. Therefore, the 18-month deadline for resolving this proceeding is December 13, 2012. On October 30, 2012, the assigned Administrative Law Judge’s (ALJ) proposed decision was issued for public review and comments. This proposed decision is before the Commission on the November 29, 2012

Agenda as Item 18. An extension of the statutory deadline until February 11, 2013, is necessary to give the Commission time to deliberate on the proposed decision.

**Waiver of Comment Period**

Under Rule 14.6 (c)(4) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Commission may reduce or waive the period for public review and comment of proposed decisions extending the deadline for resolving ratesetting proceedings. Accordingly, the otherwise applicable period for public review and comment is being waived.

**Assignment of Proceeding**

Michael R. Peevey is the assigned Commissioner and Jessica T. Hecht is the assigned ALJ in this proceeding.

**Finding of Fact**

A 60-day extension of time to February 11, 2013, is needed to give the Commission time to deliberate on the proposed decision.

**Conclusions of Law**

1. The Commission should extend the deadline in this proceeding to February 11, 2013, as allowed by Pub. Util. Code § 1701.5(a).
2. In accordance with Rule 14.6(c)(4) the comment period should be waived.

3. This order should be effective immediately.

**IT IS ORDERED** that the statutory deadline in this proceeding is extended to February 11, 2013.
