DECISION APPROVING SETTLEMENT OFFER

Complainant, Jalal Soltanian, contends that he has been billed by the Defendant, Sprint Communications Company, LP (Sprint) for international calls that he did not initiate. Sprint asserts that calling records establish that the calls originated from Mr. Soltanian’s home phone and that the bills were true and correct. Nevertheless, Sprint notes that as a good faith gesture to a valued customer, it made a settlement offer to Mr. Soltanian and credited his account the entire disputed amount (\$340). We approve Sprint’s settlement offer to the Complainant. No other relief is warranted.

Assignment of Proceeding

Catherine J.K. Sandoval is the assigned Commissioner and Karl J. Bemederfer is the assigned Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Sprint Communications Company, LP's settlement offer to Mr. Jalal Soltanian is approved.
2. Sprint will credit Mr. Soltanian's account \$340.00 and cease any collection efforts.
3. Case 12-10-014 is closed.
