ORDER EXTENDING STATUTORY DEADLINE

Summary

This decision extends the statutory deadline in this proceeding to August 28, 2013.

Background

Public Utilities Code Section 1701.2(d) provides that adjudicatory cases shall be resolved within 12 months of the date that they are initiated unless the Commission makes findings as to why that deadline cannot be met and issues an order extending that deadline. This matter has been categorized as adjudicatory, and the 12-month deadline for resolving this proceeding is February 28, 2013.

The Presiding Officer’s Decision in this proceeding was issued on January 31, 2013. An extension of the statutory deadline to August 28, 2013, is

necessary to preserve appropriate appeal and request for review rights and to allow the Commission to deliberate in this proceeding if necessary.

Waiver of Comment Period

Under Rule 14.6(c)(4) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Commission may reduce or waive the period for public review and comment of proposed decisions extending the deadline for resolving adjudicatory proceedings. Accordingly, the otherwise applicable period for public review is being waived.

Assignment of Proceeding

Mark J. Ferron is the assigned Commissioner and David M. Gamson is the assigned Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding.

Findings of Fact

1. The complaint Case 12-02-021 was initiated on February 29, 2012.
2. This proceeding must be resolved within 12 months of its statutory deadline, unless this date is extended.
3. The Presiding Officer's Decision was issued on January 31, 2013.
4. An extension of the 12-month deadline is necessary to preserve appropriate appeal and request for review rights and to allow the Commission time to deliberate in this proceeding if necessary.

Conclusions of Law

1. The 12-month statutory deadline imposed by Public Utilities Code Section 1701.2(d) should be extended until August 28, 2013.

2. This matter should be effective immediately.

IT IS ORDERED that the 12-month statutory deadline in this proceeding is extended until August 28, 2013.
