ORDER EXTENDING STATUTORY DEADLINE

Summary

This decision extends the statutory deadline in this proceeding to September 10, 2014.

Background

Public Utilities Code Section 1701.2(d) provides that adjudicatory cases shall be resolved within 12 months of the date that they are initiated unless the Commission makes findings as to why that deadline cannot be met and issues an order extending that deadline. This matter was filed under the Commission’s Expedited Complaint Procedure and the 12-month deadline for resolving this proceeding ends on July 12, 2014.

On July 12, 2013, Myron Griffin (Complainant) filed a complaint under the Commission's Expedited Complaint Procedure (ECP) Case (C.) 13-07-006, seeking that the Commission resolve the dispute with Southern California Edison Company (Defendant), regarding billing charges.

A hearing was noticed in this matter on November 6, 2013, and held on December 12, 2013. The hearing concluded after an agreement was reached which would settle the matter. The decision resolving this complaint was withheld to provide the parties additional time to perfect the settlement. The parties have been unable to perfect the settlement and the proposed decision resolving this complaint is now before the Commission. Therefore, a 60-day extension of the statutory deadline until September 10, 2014, is necessary to allow the Commission time to deliberate and issue its final decision.

Waiver of Comment Period

Under Rule 14.6(c)(4 may reduce) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Commission or waive the period for public review and comment of proposed decisions extending the deadline for resolving adjudicatory proceedings. Accordingly, pursuant to this rule, the otherwise applicable period for public review and comment is waived.

Assignment of Proceeding

Catherine J.K. Sandoval is the assigned Commissioner and Darwin E. Farrar is the assigned Administrative Law Judge in these proceedings.

Findings of Fact

1. The 12-month deadline for resolving this complaint case is July 12, 2014.
2. An extension of time until September 10, 2014, is necessary to allow the Commission time to deliberate and to issue its final decision.

Conclusions of Law

1. The statutory deadline imposed by Public Utilities Code Section 1701.2(d) should be extended until September 10, 2014.
2. This order should be effective immediately.

IT IS ORDERED that the statutory deadline in this proceeding is extended until September 10, 2014.
