Application of Pacific Gas and Electric Company for Authority to Increase Revenue Requirements to Recover the Costs to Deploy an Advanced Metering Infrastructure.

**DECISION CLOSING PROCEEDING**

Decision (D.) 06-07-027 authorized Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) to deploy an Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) project. The project included the removal of customer meters and the installation of new meters known as Smart Meters, as well as retrofitting existing meters with communications modules. An Assigned Commissioner's Ruling, dated May 4, 2010, reopened this proceeding, directing that the reports the Commission ordered PG&E to prepare in Ordering Paragraphs 4 and 16 of D.06-07-027, were to be formally filed, and further required that copies of those reports be made available to the public on an ongoing basis. PG&E has continued to comply with that ruling and has timely filed all subsequent reports. The ruling did not reclose the proceeding.

It is not necessary for this proceeding to remain open in order for PG&E to continue to file the status reports prepared pursuant to Ordering Paragraphs 4 and 16 of D.06-07-027. Therefore we close this proceeding.

**1. Comments on Proposed Decision**

The proposed decision was served for public comments. Only one entity filed. Californians for Renewable Energy, Inc. filed comments on November 10, 2014, but failed to provide any relevant reason as to why the proceeding should not be closed. We therefore disregard these comments. There is no reason to modify the proposed decision.

**2. Assignment of Proceeding**

Catherine J.K. Sandoval is the assigned Commissioner and Douglas M. Long is the assigned Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding.

**Findings of Fact**

1. This proceeding was reopened in order to make the reports the Commission ordered Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) to prepare in Ordering Paragraphs 4 and 16 of Decision (D.) 06-07-027, to be formally filed, and required that copies of those reports be made available to the public on an ongoing basis.

2. PG&E has continued to comply with the Assigned Commissioner's Ruling.

**Conclusion of Law**

There is no need for the proceeding to remain open while PG&E continues to file the reports the Commission ordered PG&E to prepare in Ordering Paragraphs 4 and 16 of D.06-07-027 on a continuing basis.

**O R D E R**

**IT IS ORDERED** that Application 05-06-028 is closed.
