RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION ALJ-310. Dismissing the Appeal of Pacific Gas and Electric Company of Citation No. ALJ-274 15-01-004 Issued by the Safety and Enforcement Division.

SUMMARY

On February 9, 2015, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) timely appealed Citation No. ALJ-274 15-01-004 issued by the Safety and Enforcement Division. On April 30, 2015, PG&E moved to dismiss the instant appeal. PG&E explained the Safety and Enforcement Division provided clarification regarding the basis for the citation. PG&E has agreed to pay the full amount of the assessed fine of \$150,000 by April 30, 2015. PG&E's motion to dismiss is unopposed.

Citation Appeal (K.15-02-016), the Appeal of Pacific Gas and Electric Company of Citation No. ALJ-274 15-01-004, should be dismissed because there are no remaining issues for the Commission to resolve.

WAIVER OF REVIEW

No public review or comment is required for this resolution pursuant to Rule 14.7 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the appeal of Pacific Gas and Electric Company of Citation No. ALJ-274 15-01-004 is dismissed with prejudice.
