RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION ALJ-317. Resolves K.15-05-019, the Appeal of Masoud Zahedi Seysan, d/b/a Black Royal Limousine (TCP 34876) Citation No. SED LAX-964.

SUMMARY

This resolution resolves the appeal of Citation No. SED LAX-964 issued to Masoud Z. Seysan (Seysan), dba Black Royal Limousine (TCP 34876), by the California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) on May 7, 2015.¹ SED notified the assigned Administrative Law Judge that it had rescinded Citation No. SED LAX-964 on July 3, 2015. SED requested the matter be dismissed.

The Commission regulates charter-party carriers of passengers primarily pursuant to the Passenger Charter-Party Carriers' Act (Pub. Util. Code § 5351, et seq.) Pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187, issued by the Commission on September 22, 2005, SED² is authorized to issue citations to various classes of transportation carriers for violation of the Public Utilities Code and/or Commission orders. In turn, a carrier issued such a citation may accept the fine imposed or contest it through a process of appeal under Resolution ALJ-299.³

¹ SED cited Mr. Seysan for engaging at least one employee without having Worker's Compensation Insurance or a certificate of consent to self-insure issued by the Director of Industrial Relations on file; for failure to update and maintain an equipment lease of all vehicles in use under its certificate; and failure to produce a valid waybill upon request.

² ALJ-187 confers authority on the Consumer Protection and Safety Division now known as the Safety and Enforcement Division.

³ The Commission issued Resolution ALJ-299 on June 26, 2014 for application beginning on January 1, 2015.

On May 22, 2015, Seysan appealed Citation SED LAX-964. Subsequently, SED rescinded the citation and on July 3, 2015, SED requested the matter be closed. No hearing was held. Because Citation SED LAX-964 has been rescinded, this proceeding should be closed.

ASSIGNMENT OF PROCEEDING

Katherine Kwan MacDonald is the assigned Administrative Law Judge to this citation appeal.

1. Citation SED LAX-964 was rescinded by the Safety and Enforcement Division. As a result, the Appeal of Masoud Zahedi Seysan, dba Black Royal Limousine (TCP 34876) from Citation SED LAX-964 is moot.
2. This proceeding is closed.
