**CPUC TO HOLD WORKSHOP AND PUBLIC PARTICIPATION HEARING
ON CALIFORNIA-AMERICAN WATER'S PROPOSED
MONTEREY PENINSULA WATER SUPPLY PROJECT**

SAN FRANCISCO, August 24, 2016 - The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) will hold a workshop and Public Participation Hearing related to California-American Water Company's proposed Monterey Peninsula Water Supply Project.

At the workshop, the CPUC will provide an update on specific elements of the ongoing environmental review, including the peer review results, of the Ground Water Model by the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, the revised Ground Water Model, and the incorporation of test well data into the model. The workshop is also an opportunity for parties and attendees to ask questions and provide comments on these subjects.
