Participants of the working group will identify and assess opportunities in which VGI can create value from multiple market participants' perspectives, communication protocols needed to deliver that value, and concepts for how utilities, automakers, electric vehicle service providers, aggregators, and others can develop pathways to market for a VGI resource.

The working group will allow participants to review, understand, and discuss the technical details of existing communication protocols. The recommendations of the working group will be considered and incorporated in CPUC's Rulemaking 13-11-007 (and/or the SB 350 Transportation Electrification applications A.17-01-020, A.17-01-021 and A.17-01-022) and the Energy Commission's Integrated Energy Policy Report (IEPR) proceeding for future policy decisions. SB 745 also extends the date by which remaining funds from the BPHA shall be transferred back to other CASF Accounts from December 31, 2016 to December 31, 2020. In addition, SB 745 changes eligibility requirements for the CASF Rural and Urban Regional Broadband Consortia Account (Consortia Account) and makes modifications to the CASF program reporting requirements.
