## CPUC TO HOLD SEPTEMBER 28 VOTING MEETING IN CHULA VISTA

SAN FRANCISCO, September 12, 2017 - The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) will hold its September 28<sup>th</sup> Voting Meeting in Chula Vista, Calif.

WHEN: Thursday, September 28, 2017, 9:30 a.m.

**WHERE**: Chula Vista Council Chambers, 276 Fourth Ave., Chula Vista, CA 91910; also available via listen-only call-in number at 1-800-857-1917, passcode 92105

WHAT: The CPUC's Commissioners will discuss and vote on proposed policies.

The Voting Meeting begins with public comment, and members of the public are encouraged to attend. Those intending to make public comment can sign-up to speak in person before the meeting starts, or can sign-up online in advance at <a href="https://ia.cpuc.ca.gov/requesttocomment/">https://ia.cpuc.ca.gov/requesttocomment/</a>.

The CPUC typically holds Voting Meetings twice a month at its headquarters in San Francisco, but also schedules Voting Meetings in other cities throughout the state. In addition, the CPUC holds many Public Participation Hearings and other events statewide in order to reach out to consumers.
