**RESOLUTION REVOKING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY OF SAEED O. IBRAHIM
(PSG0034342), FOR FAILURE TO SUBMIT COMPLIANCE FILINGS
IN ACCORDANCE WITH DECISION NO. 15-03-027.**

SUMMARY

This Resolution revokes the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) of Saeed O. Ibrahim (PSG0034342), for failure to submit compliance filings. The authority to revoke the CPCN for this reason was granted in Decision (D.)15-03-027, Ordering Paragraph 7.

BACKGROUND

Saeed O. Ibrahim (Ibrahim) applied for a CPCN to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation in Application (A.)14-08-017. Ibrahim was granted a CPCN in D.15-03-027. Ibrahim was ordered to file with the Commission:

- Public Liability & Property Damage (PL&PD) Insurance (Pub. Util. Code § 1040).
- Evidence of workers' compensation insurance (Pub. Util. Code §§ 324, 460.7, and 1043).
- Evidence of compliance with the controlled substances and alcohol testing requirements (Pub. Util. Code § 1032.1).
- Tariffs (Pub. Util. Code § 486 et seq.).
- Letter of acceptance.

Ibrahim failed to submit this information to the Commission. Ibrahim also failed to respond to written correspondence from staff on November 29, 2017.

DISCUSSION

Ordering Paragraph 2 of D.15-03-027 requires Ibrahim to receive a notice from CPED that its evidence of insurance has been filed with the Commission and that the California Highway Patrol has approved the use of the Applicant's vehicles for service. Ibrahim failed to submit such compliance information to CPED.

Ordering Paragraph 7 of D.15-03-027 requires Ibrahim to exercise its CPCN within 120 days of the date of the order (March 26, 2015), or the CPNC will expire. Ibrahim failed to exercise its CPCN within 120 days of the order, and therefore, the CPCN should be revoked.

COMMENTS ON DRAFT RESOLUTION

To comply with Pub. Util. Code § 311(g), the Consumer Protection and Enforcement Division commenced publication of a Daily Calendar notice on February 21, 2018 that apprised the public of the availability of its draft of this resolution and solicited submission of comments by March 5, 2018.

FINDINGS

1. D.15-03-027 required Ibrahim to submit evidence of Public Liability & Property Damage (PL&PD) Insurance; Ibrahim failed to do so within 120 days of the decision.
2. D.15-03-027 required Ibrahim to submit evidence of workers' compensation insurance; Ibrahim failed to do so within 120 days of the decision.
3. D.15-03-027 required Ibrahim to submit evidence of compliance with the controlled substances and alcohol testing requirements; Ibrahim failed to do so within 120 days of the decision.
4. D.15-03-027 required Ibrahim to file Tariffs; Ibrahim failed to do so within 120 days of the decision.
5. D.15-03-027 required Ibrahim to file a Letter of acceptance; Ibrahim failed to do so within 120 days of the decision.
6. Ibrahim's CPCN expired per Ordering Paragraph 7 of D.15-03-027
7. Ibrahim can't be contacted by staff.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to Saeed O. Ibrahim (PSG0034342), is revoked.
2. A copy of this resolution shall be placed in the Commission's formal file for Application No. 14-08-0157

This resolution is effective today.
