Draft Resolution T-17616 may be heard, at the earliest, on the Commission's November 8, 2018, meeting agenda. Resolution T-17616 seeks to authorize flow through revenue requirement and resulting California High Cost Fund-A changes from the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 for six Small Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers. This resolution adopts a reduction in California High Cost Fund-A support of \$1,291,652 to \$18,228,176, for the period April 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018 during Calendar Year 2018, for six Small Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers.

This draft resolution is available at the Commission's website at [www.cpuc.ca.gov](http://www.cpuc.ca.gov). On November 8, 2018, the Commission may vote on this resolution or it may postpone votes until later. When the Commission votes on a draft resolution, it may adopt all or part of it as written, amend or modify it, or set it aside and prepare a different resolution. Only when the Commission acts does a resolution become binding on the parties. The conformed resolution, when adopted by the Commission, will be available at the same website.

Pursuant to Public Utilities (PU) Code 311 (g), the above-identified draft resolution is available for public comments. Comments should be focused on factual, legal, and/or technical errors in the draft resolution. Comments must be limited to five pages in length and shall include a subject index listing the recommendations to the draft resolution, a table of authorities, and an appendix setting forth the proposed revised findings and ordering paragraphs.

The date of submission is the date the Communications Division receives the comments. Parties must serve a copy of their comments on the same day to the Communications Division staff contact Michael Coen [michael.coen@cpuc.ca.gov](mailto:michael.coen@cpuc.ca.gov) and each party set forth on the service list attached to the draft resolution on the same date that the comments are submitted to the Communications Division. **PLEASE DO NOT REPLY TO THIS E-MAIL, THIS IS AN UNMONITORED ADDRESS AND REPLIES TO THIS E-MAIL CANNOT BE RESPONDED TO OR READ.**

**Comments must be submitted within 20 days of it being noticed in the Daily Calendar which is October 25, 2018.**

Late-filed opening comments and/or reply comments will ordinarily be rejected. However, in extraordinary circumstances, a request for leave to submit comments or replies late may be filed together with proposed comments/replies. An accompanying declaration under penalty of perjury shall be submitted setting forth all the reasons for the late submission.
