CPUC SETS ADDITIONAL VOTING MEETING FOR JANUARY 28

SAN FRANCISCO, January 28, 2019 - The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) will hold an emergency Voting Meeting pursuant to Government Code section 11125.5, as follows:

WHEN: Monday, January 28, 2019, 2:30 p.m.

WHERE: CPUC Auditorium, 505 Van Ness Ave., San Francisco; also available via webcast at www.adminmonitor.com/ca/cpuc/ or listen-only phone line at 1-800-857-1917, passcode 92105

WHY: The CPUC must address a Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) request for an exemption from the application of Public Utilities Code sections 817, 818, 823, and 851, regarding review of financial transactions, prior to January 29, 2019. PG&E filed an expedited request for an exemption on January 18, 2019, and stated that CPUC action is needed prior to January 29, 2019, when PG&E expects to make a filing for reorganization under Chapter 11 in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court.
