The Commission will also consider comments submitted by parties in response to the original publishing of Draft Resolution T-17658 on August 8, 2019.

**Draft Resolution T-17658** will be on the Commission's **October 10, 2019**, meeting agenda. Resolution **T-17658** proposes approving additional California Advanced Services Fund (CASF) funding of up to \$9,061,201 to Race Communications Inc. (Race) to complete the Gigafy Phelan Project. On **October 10, 2019,** the Commission may vote on this resolution or it may postpone votes until later. Comments on this draft resolution must be submitted no later than **September 30, 2019**. Reply comments will be accepted no later than **October 3, 2019**.

Late-filed opening comments and/or reply comments will ordinarily be rejected. However, in extraordinary circumstances, a request for leave to submit comments or replies late may be filed together with proposed comments/replies. An accompanying declaration under penalty of perjury shall be submitted setting forth all the reasons for the late submission.
