**CPUC TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARING ON EXPO LINE'S REQUEST
TO BUILD CROSSING AND PASSENGER STATION**

SAN FRANCISCO, May 28, 2010 -- The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) will hold a Public Participation Hearing (PPH) on the Exposition Construction Authority's request to construct a grade crossing at Farmdale Avenue near Dorsey High School in Los Angeles, including the addition of a passenger station.

WHEN: June 1, 2010, 6 p.m. – 8 p.m.

WHERE: Dorsey High School – Cafeteria, 3537 Farmdale Ave., Los Angeles
Note: Dorsey's parking lot is currently under construction. Parking and shuttle service will be available at Rancho Cienega Sports Complex at 5001 Rodeo Rd.

WHY: To receive public comment on the settlement agreement between the Exposition Construction Authority and the Los Angeles Unified School District, which was filed on May 12, 2010. The settlement agreement provides for an Expo Line passenger station at the Farmdale Avenue intersection, such that all trains will come to a complete stop before entering the intersection. The settlement agreement also provides that the Farmdale Avenue crossing of the Expo line will remain open to vehicles and pedestrians.

Comments from the public can help the CPUC reach an informed decision and members of the public are encouraged to attend the hearing.
