### **Data Request 9:**

### **AT&T Supplemental Response to Data Request 9:**

On July 6, 2011, AT&T Mobility provided BATES **ATTITMCA006107-ATTITMCA006340** (**HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL**) and **BATES ATTITMCA006341** (**HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL**) in response to this data request. AT&T Mobility hereby supplements its response.

AT&T Mobility supplements its response by providing BATES **ATTITMCA006394-ATTITMCA006396** (**HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL**), which reflect data for the month of April 2011 for channel terminations purchased from Verizon. As we explained in our July 6 response, we have not been able to locate the exact data required to populate the Tab 2. Specifically, we have not been able to identify (1) the Price Cap/ Price Flexibility designation for each channel termination (we have identified a category of channel terminations that are Price Caps and another category where we cannot determine if the purchase was Price Cap or Price Flexibility), (2) the terms in months/years for all the channel terminations purchased; (3) the final price paid for each channel termination, and (4) whether each end office is also a switching wire center (SWC). Although we have not found the exact data requested, we have populated Tab 2 with the data derived from a review of invoices, and we have attached Notes to explain the data.
