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Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby provides proof of compliance with Rule 13.1 of the California Public Utilities Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

In a ruling dated April 6, 2012, Assigned Administrative Law Judge Richard Clark set one public participation hearing (PPH) with two sessions for May 8, 2012. The ALJ Ruling directed that notice of the PPH be provided by postcard mailing, advertisements in newspapers of general circulation, and notices posted in payment centers. In an email dated April 16, 2012, PG&E notified ALJ Clark that it would notify most of its customers by bill insert and sought approval to use alternative means to notify the remaining customers. On April 17, 2012, ALJ Clark authorized PG&E to use purchased media and earned media to notify customers in its service territory south of the southern borders of the counties of Alameda, San Joaquin, Calaveras and Alpine Counties.

Attachment A demonstrates that PG&E has met the notice requirements set forth in the ALJ Ruling dated April 6, 2012, as subsequently modified by the ALJ email dated April 17, 2012. Attachment B demonstrates that PG&E has met the notice requirement specified in the ALJ Ruling and Rule 13.1(b) by timely posting notices of the PPH in its front counter offices and publishing the notice in newspapers of general circulation within its service area. Attachments C and D demonstrate that PG&E met the notice requirement specified in the ALJ Ruling and Rule 13.1, by mailing a bill insert of the PPH notice to customers beginning April 16 and ending

May 7, 2012, and publishing the notice in newspapers of general circulation within its service area.
