Meredith Allen, Senior Director, Regulatory Relations, PG&E, initiated the communication with Matthew Tisdale, Advisor to Commissioner Michel Florio. Ms. Allen stated that the Commission should approve the Alternate Decision, which authorizes PG&E to recover net costs of \$9.9 million for a solar PV R&D project as cost share for a DOE grant of \$30 million.
