BY THE UNION OF CONCERNED SCIENTISTS**


Pursuant to Rule 8.4 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Union of Concerned Scientists (“UCS”) respectfully reports the following ex parte communication.

On March 26, 2012, Jasmin Ansar, Climate Economist met with Dr. Bishu Chatterjee, Advisor to Commissioner Simon, for approximately 45 minutes. The meeting took place at 1:15 pm, at the offices of the California Public Utilities Commission and then at a nearby restaurant (Melange). The meeting was initiated by Ms. Ansar.

Ms Ansar summarized UCS’s and the Joint Parties position on the allocation of revenues generated from the sale of greenhouse gas (“GHG”) allowances. Ms. Ansar emphasized the importance of returning allowance value to retail customers on a non-volumetric basis to retain the carbon price signal in retail rates and preserve incentives for energy efficiency. Ms Ansar also discussed the recommendations of both the Economic and Allocation Advisory Committee (EAAC) and the Economic and Technology Advancement and Advisory Committee (ETAAC) that argued for a portion of allowance value be used to strategically fund longer term carbon reductions initiatives.
