Pursuant to Article 8 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), The California Black Chamber of Commerce (“CBCC”) hereby files this notice of an ex parte meeting with Commissioner Timothy Simon, his Chief of Staff, Phyllis White, his Senior Energy Advisor, Bishu Chatterjee, and Utility Supplier Diversity Officer, Douglas Phason.

On Tuesday, June 5, 2012 at 3:00 p.m., Aubry Stone, President and Chief Executive Officer of CBCC; and Phyllis A. Marshall, outside counsel to CBCC, conducted a telephonic meeting with Commissioner Simon, Ms. White, Mr. Chatterjee, and Mr. Phason. The meeting lasted approximately forty-five minutes and consisted of oral communications only. The meeting was held at CBCC’s request. Mr. Stone discussed general issues of contract readiness for small businesses to compete for contract opportunities, and small business opportunities under the State’s new retrofit program for State buildings. Briefly, Southern California Edison’s (“SCE”) general rate case was discussed, concerning CBCC’s testimony supporting the expansion of opportunities for small businesses.¹

¹ As CBCC did not anticipate that the SCE general rate case would be discussed, a three day prior notice was not served.
