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Pursuant to Article 8 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), California-American Water Company (“California American Water” or “the Company”) hereby files this notice of an ex parte meeting with Commissioner Mark Ferron’s Chief of Staff, Charlotte TerKeurst, and his advisor, Michael Colvin.

On Tuesday June 12, 2012, at 1:35 p.m., Jeffrey T. Linam, Vice President of Finance; David P. Stephenson, Director of Rates; and Sarah E. Leeper, Vice President – Legal, Regulatory met Ms. TerKeurst and Mr. Colvin at the Commission’s offices at 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California for approximately 30 minutes. The meeting consisted of oral and written communications. California American Water requested the meeting in order to discuss its support for the alternative proposed decision (“APD”). California American Water provided a handout, attached hereto as Attachment 1, which highlighted how further delays in the construction timeline could impact the ability of public agencies to secure funding from private donors and jeopardize state funding earmarked for the proposed project. The handout also included the Company’s rebuttals to the assertions made by the Division of Ratepayer Advocates

in its opening and reply comments to the APD.
